INSTRUCTIONS

The Australian Cowgirl Hall of Fame honours and celebrates women, past and present, whose lives and relationships with and around horses, nationally and internationally, exemplify the courage, resilience, and independence that also helped shape the Western culture in Australia. The Australian Cowgirl proudly celebrates living and deceased honourees who represent diverse backgrounds, ethnicities and cultures.

To be considered for induction to the Hall of Fame, a Nomination Form must be completed for each nominee. Instructions contained on this form must be followed or your nomination will be returned.

GENERAL (RITERIA

Nominees may be contemporary or historical. It is not necessary for her to be a citizen of Australia. Their contribution(s) should be of Local, National or international importance and of enduring value.

Important Note: please see our Nomination and Induction Information page on our website before completing your nomination as many questions may be answered in that information.

Please carefully consider the following:

- * Nominator MUST receive permission from the nominee in order to apply
- * Completed forms must be received prior to 31st December each year.
- Nomination forms and supporting materials must be submitted Unbound on traditional A4 size paper, on a USB or emailed. Supporting documents are to be posted via mail.
- * If the nomination form is formally accepted, your person officially becomes a NOMINEE of the Hall of Fame. The nomination will be filed in The Australian Cowgirl Hall of Fame archives, reviewed every year during the induction selection process, and made available for researchers throughout the year.
- * All materials sent in the nomination packet are a permanent donation to The Australian Cowgirl and become its property for future display purposes.
- * If you are in doubt regarding certain information, state best known facts and identify with a (?) following the unverifiable information listed.



- * If additional space is needed in filling out the nomination form please add pages.
- * In addition to the nomination form, the letter of support is to be attached with supporting documentation. Explaining how the nominee has influenced her field on a local, national or international level.
- * Additional material such as news clippings, articles, photographs, letters and other relevant reference materials are encouraged, Items received and accepted as a potential candidate or as a subject file will be considered permanent donations to The Australian Cowgirl for future displays purposes, however copies would be sufficient.
- You will receive an acknowledgement of materials letter when the nomination packet is received by us within in one month you will receive notification of receipt of the packet, should you not hear from us please follow up.
- * Persons nominated should be aware of the fact that any information listed will be made accessible to the public or media.
